DID YOU KNOW ONE OUT OF EVERY SEVENTEEN CAR COLLISIONS INVOLVES WANDERING WILDLIFE? WE NOT ONLY SHARE THE ROAD WITH OTHER MOTORISTS, BUT WE ALSO SHARE IT WITH THE ANIMALS. HERE ARE A FEW TIPS TO AVOID COLLISIONS WITH CROSSING WILDLIFE. FIRST, KNOW THAT WILDLIFE IS MOST ACTIVE AT DUSK, DAWN, AND NIGHT. STAY ALERT AND BE ESPECIALLY AWARE AT THESE TIMES. PAY ATTENTION TO THE ROAD SHOULDERS. THOUGH ANIMALS MAY BE ON THE SIDE, THEY MAY UNEXPECTEDLY FLEE INTO THE ROAD. ALSO KNOW THAT SEVERAL WILDLIFE SUCH AS DEER AND ELK WANDER IN GROUPS, SO IF YOU SEE ONE CONTINUE WITH CAUTION AS MORE WILL PROBABLY FOLLOW.

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
